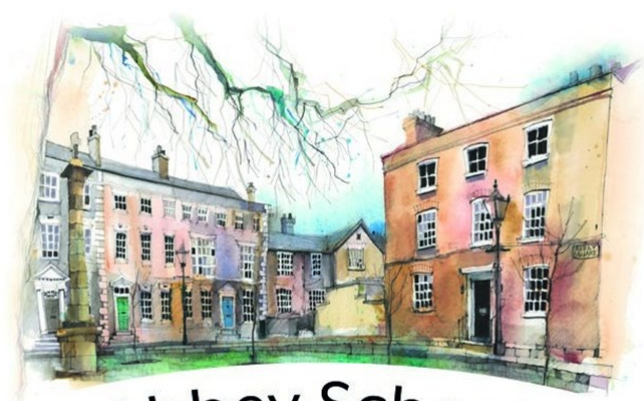

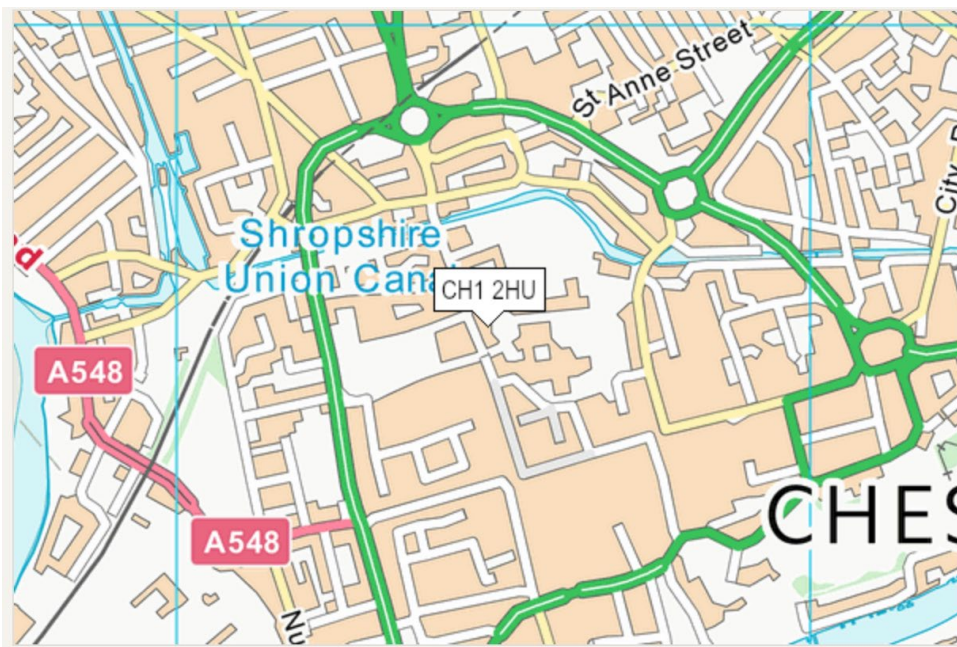
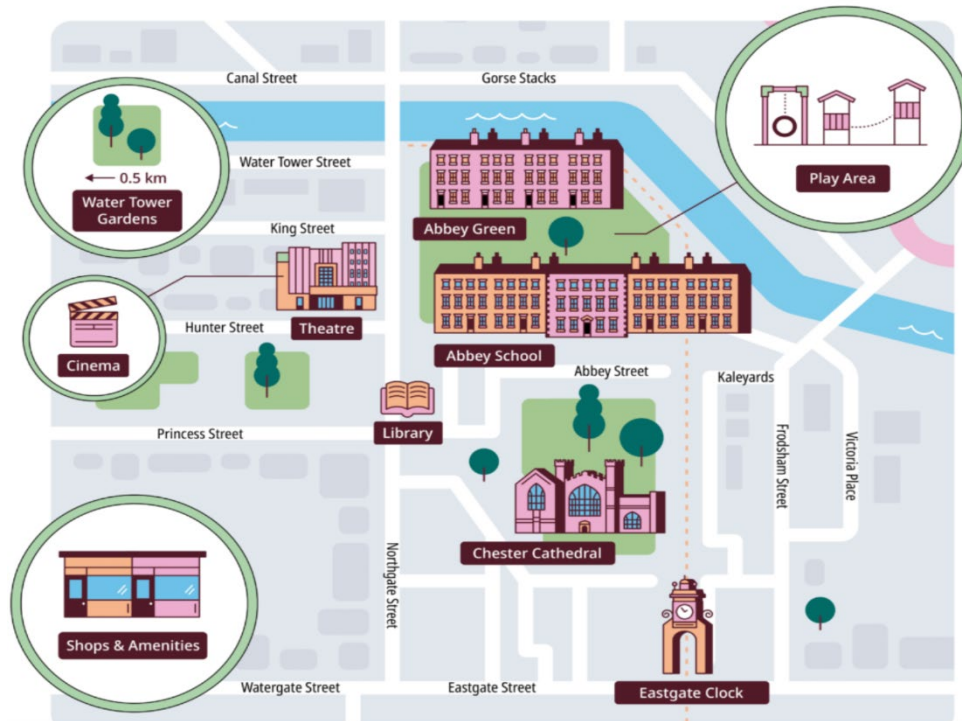
Welcome to Abbey Green Residential

Our brand-new residential provision, Abbey Green. Providing a high standard of accommodation and support that extends our school-based learning through a waking-day curriculum of fun-filled activity, at home and in the community.

Abbey School's residential accommodation Abbey Green is located in the beautiful newly refurbished mews buildings on the Abbey School grounds in the heart of Chester City Centre. There is safe pedestrian access to the school via walled gardens. The building provides a safe, comfortable, and inviting living environment for pupils aged 8 to 19 years. Furnished and decorated by award winning designers, each house has its own garden and outdoor space, along with a lounge, kitchen, and activity area as well as private bedrooms and bathrooms. Pupils are encouraged to personalise their own area of the house based on their interests and preferences.

A Day in Abbey Green

07.30am - Day staff arrive, and young people can start to morning routine.

08:00-8:30am - Breakfast in the house

08:55am - Walk to school with your Abbey Green staff where you will be greeted by your education staff.

09:00am-3:15pm - School Day.

3:15pm - End of school day. Abbey Green Staff will pick you up and bring you back your house.

3:15pm-4:00pm - Changed from school uniform and have some snack.

4:00pm-6:00pm - Activities.

6:00pm-7:00pm - Evening meal (maybe earlier for younger children)

7:00pm-8:00pm - Clean up after meal before starting evening routine.

8:00pm-10:00pm - Complete evening routine depending upon bedtime. Bath/Shower, and supper before bed.

Calls to family members will be after tea but before bed, should parents wish to.

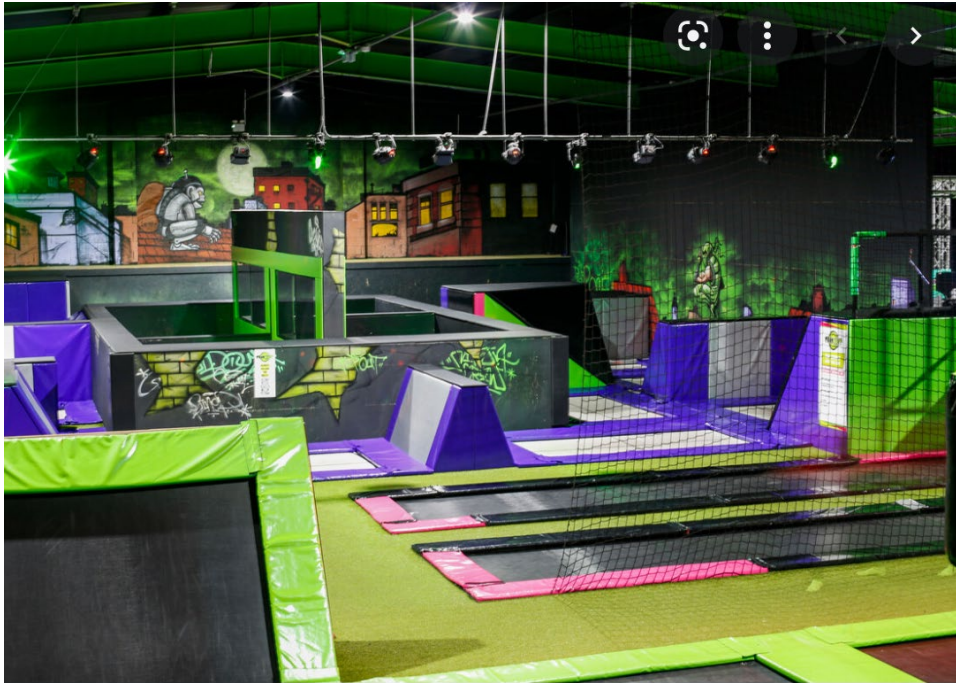
